**East Side Development Plan**

KBA Directors have been invited to participate in updating the East Side Development Plan for the Kapaa/Wailua region. Keith Nitta, Senior Planner with the County, and Earl Matsukawa, with the consulting firm Wilson Okamoto addressed the KBA board to outline the process.

A Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) has been formed (which includes KBA Directors). After the committee convenes, there will be small group meetings within the community focusing on creating a vision for the region.

The Consultant and the Planning Department are currently in the data gathering stage. Meetings have already taken place with large landowners regarding their plans and with various government agencies on both the State and County levels. Data related to population, housing units, hotel rooms, etc. is also being gathered.

The Planning Department has been meeting with the different consulting firms doing plans for both State and County agencies, with the idea of coordinating all on-going planning efforts to avoid overlap, establish consistency and share information to avoid unnecessary costs.

This plan will have a huge impact on the future of the East Side. KBA members are encouraged to participate in the process and helping to define the East Side by joining KBA's committee on this issue.

This is an exciting time to be a member for KBA. We are looking at so many opportunities to have a voice in our future.

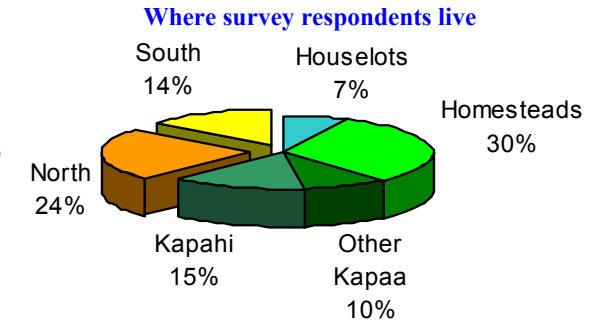
## Pouli Road connector to bypass in State Legislature

A huge MAHALO to the Mayor and County Council for submitting a request to the State Legislature to fund land acquisition and planning for improving and extending Pouli Road from Kuhio Highway to the existing Kapa'a bypass road.

Recently, KBA conducted a survey to gain feedback from the business and residential communities regarding two related ideas: 1) to extend Pouli Road (the road between the Fire station & Waipouli shopping center from Kuhio Highway to the temporary bypass road .

The survey generated interest from Kauai residents all over the island. Of the 455 surveys collected, 62% were from people who live in the Kapaa/Wailua area. The remaining surveys came from residents both north and south of Kapaa, but impacted by the traffic in the region.

The importance and use of the bypass will increase with the bypass extension being completed. We believe a feeder road, from the bypass directly to shopping centers should become an integral & necessary part of the bypass system, taking cars off of Kuhio Highway (See drawing). The proposed road would also serve as a relief route, in the event of a natural disaster.



The feeder road will allow the ever-increasing number of residents in the Homesteads, Kapahi, North Kapa'a & the Northshore (via the upcoming bypass extension) to easily access shopping without suffering through, and exacerbating, the traffic congestion in Kapa'a. The planning department estimates 3200 + households (11,200 residents), in the Northern Kapa'a area alone, could access shopping without adding congestion to the Kapa'a section of Kuhio Highway.

### BLOSSOMING LOTUS

Meet Mark Reinfeld and Gabe Zingaro



Find renewal (symbolic meaning of the lotus plant) at the vegan restaurant, Blossoming Lotus in the Dragon Building in downtown Kapaa.

Brain child of entrepreneur Gabe Zingaro and vegan Chef Mark Reinfeld the restaurant offers cuisine inspired by many regions and prepared without

meat or dairy products. Because people are expecting lettuce with a side of carrot sticks they are pleasantly surprised to find that the menu contains fresh, locally grown organic food prepared in a diverse mix of cooking styles and flavors.

Their first restaurant, The Lotus Root, still serves as a juice bar, bakery and catering kitchen. All of their 3 restaurants (2 on Kauai and 1 in Portland, Oregon) are worker owned and follow the seed to table principles of the original restaurant. They call their style “Vegan Fusion” and the menus incorporate cooking techniques and flavors from 13 regions of the world. The restaurant attracts visiting chefs from around the world. The current guest chef is from the only vegan restaurant in Munich, Germany.

Gabe thinks of the East Side as the merging point on the island due to its economic, agricultural and urban diversity. He would like to see improvement to the traffic, more community parks, and alternative energy including solar and sugar cane by-products.

So don't let the term “vegan” intimidate you. You may find yourself in for a surprise. Most diner's return after trying it, even the most dedicated carnivores. On a special note Mark Reinfeld is co-author with Bo Rinaldi of “Vegan World Fusion Cuisine” which contains award winning recipes and has a forward by Jane Goodall.

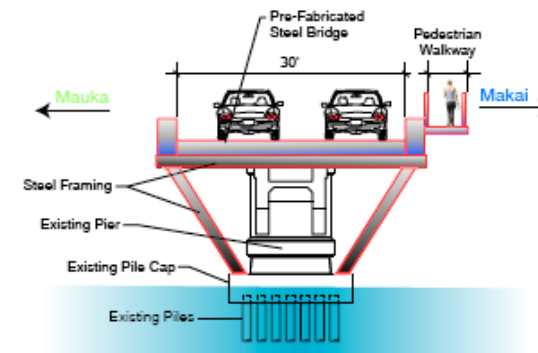
## DOT begins meetings on widening Kuhio Highway and Bridges

The State Department of Transportation is beginning the process of widening Kuhio highway across the Wailua River up to the Bypass.

There is progress on the construction of the Coastal Trail project. Tim Bynum, Committee Chair, reported that the contract for the section of the trail from Alkali to Nawiliwili has been awarded. The Kapaa section is scheduled for completion in November 2006.

The Alahale Makalai group needs support to keep the trail on its coastal route. KBA members will participate in a one day confer-

ence in November to continue working on this issue with other trail organizations.

We have supported this project by participating in public and private planning meetings, by writing letters and giving testimony to the County Council and by voicing our position on local



radio. We believe that the trail will have a positive impact on the quality of life in Kauai. It will provide an accessible scenic trail for the use and enjoyment of residents and

visitors.
